THE PRECESSION OF THE EQUINOXES

Earth's axis doesn't point at a fixed spot in space. It wobbles like a spinning top, tracing a circle against the backdrop of the stars over approximately 25,772 years.

This cycle—the precession of the equinoxes—means that the constellation behind the sun at the spring equinox slowly shifts. We move through the zodiacal 'ages': from Pisces into Aquarius, and onward.

The Mayans tracked this with extraordinary precision. Their Long Count calendar spans 5,125 years per Great Cycle. Five Great Cycles equals approximately 25,625 years—matching precession almost exactly.

PRECESSION IN THE ϵ FRAMEWORK

Just as you have a position on your local torus (connected to your quantum twin through tube- ϵ), Earth has a position on a larger cosmic torus. The precession cycle is Earth's orbit around that structure.

THE GALACTIC TORUS

The galaxy itself has toroidal structure. Our solar system doesn't just orbit the galactic center—it oscillates above and below the galactic plane, weaving a helical path. This motion takes roughly 26,000 years to complete one 'wobble.'
